Enclosed is a Petition signed by seventeen (17) of the 21 home owners on Swafford Road.

Every house I visited had the exact same complaints about the road. First, the road is too narrow for drivers to drive any faster than 25 – 30 miles per hour. Second, the blind curve on the road is too narrow and too steep for any driver to drive any faster than 10 – 15 miles per hour safely.


The initial reason for getting signatures on this petition was that twice in one week I almost had a head-on collision with a young driver in a green Jeep Wrangler. I was driving up the hill in the blind curve and she was driving down the hill. We met in the middle and she was driving way too fast for the road conditions. I pulled over into the ditch to avoid a head-on collision with the Jeep. She swerved back to her side of the road and almost lost control of her vehicle.

I have changed the time I leave my house to go to work to avoid the busy school traffic driving towards Pippin Road.

Swafford Road is in desperate need of speed limit signs, as well as other road signs to improve driver safety.

Pursuant to Article IV of the Joint Venture Agreement between Putnam County and the City of Cookeville, the Putnam County Commission appoints four members of the seven members of the Putnam County Library Board and one of two representatives to the Regional Library Board.

The term of Dr. Gerald Barker is expiring at the end of June, 2013. Dr. Barker, a veterinarian practicing at the Copeland Veterinary Hospital, has agreed to continue serving on the Library Board.
